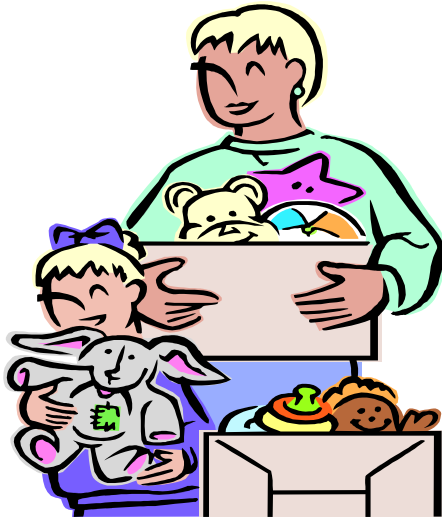
The Elkhart Area Career Center has received their accreditation.

American Culinary Federation Scholarship **Benefactor**

American Culinary Federation, South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association

Selection Criteria

A committee comprised of representation from the American Culinary Federation, South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association will make selection based on the following criteria:

A student in the Hospitality Administration program at Ivy Tech State College—North Central Region.

Must be Student Member of the ACF, South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association.

Must have participated in a minimum of twelve (12) hours of ACF sanctioned events and no less than two events.

Have successfully completed at least fifteen (15) quality credit hours, of which six (6) must be in the Hospitality Administration Program.

The student will possess an overall GPA of at least 3.0.

The Hospitality Administration faculty will assist with the identification of applicants.

Funds may be used for tuition, books, fees and supplies.

Full or part time student.

Selection information will be forwarded to the Director of Financial Aid.

Award

Award will not exceed \$500/semester, with a minimum award of not less than \$100/semester.

Student Requirement

Students applying for the American Culinary Federation scholarship will submit a resume that includes personal, educational, and employment information.

An essay on the person most influential in your life. (approx 200 words)

Letter of recommendation from a Chef member verifying 12 hours participation in two ACF events.

Applications will be submitted by August 1 for the fall semester and December 1 for spring semester awards.

Fund Agreement

1. The fund asset will be deposited in the Ivy Tech Foundation and distributed according to the policies and guidelines of the Foundation and this scholarship fund.
2. This agreement may be amended by the mutual consent of the Foundation and American Culinary Federation, South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association during their lifetimes. If changed circumstances should at some future time cause the continuation of this fund to be inappropriate or impractical, and the donors either are not living or are not able to consent to an amendment, then the foundation may redesignate the purpose of the fund and the income there from, providing that the fund shall continue to bear the name American Culinary Federation, South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association Scholarship Fund and that the amended terms shall adhere as closely as possible to the donor's original intent for the fund.
