

# American Culinary Federation South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association Junior Member ACF Scholarship Application

The South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association offer this scholarship to parties interested in joining the American Culinary Federation (ACF) as a Junior member and are active in a culinary training program.

The South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association offers to pay a one year junior membership fee to the ACF. The member will be an ACF member in the South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association Chapter. The party must also be enrolled in a culinary training program associated with the South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association Chapter. At the current time, but not limited to, the Chapters apprenticeship program, Ivy Tech of South Bend, and Pro Start are programs associated with the South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association Chapter.

The party accepting the scholarship is expected to remain in a culinary training program maintaining a 2.5 G.P.A. on a 4.0 scale, volunteer for a minimum of two sponsored ACF events putting in a minimum of 12 hours, and attend at least 75% of all meetings held by the chapter, within the academic calendar, following the acceptance of the scholarship and official enrollment into the American Culinary Federation's-South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association.

The Scholarship may be awarded only by a majority vote of present South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association board members. The board will consider, at a scheduled board meeting, any party that has had this application submitted by any member of the South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association. The sponsor must submit a letter of recommendation along with the application to any board member. The board will take into account the recommendation of the chapter member, financial need of the applicant, and any culinary training that the applicant has received in the past 2 years. Previous training does not have to have been associated with the South Bend Chefs and Cooks Association.

The funds for the scholarship will be withdrawn from the general coffers of the chapter. An estimated line item of the costs is to be included in the annual budget. The treasurer will maintain all records of scholarships in the treasury records.
